JOINT RESOLUTION

Recognizing the Desert Shield-Desert Storm Memorial Light at the Shrine of Our Lady of Grace in Columbia, New Hampshire, as a memorial of national significance.

Whereas in 1990, the people of Coos County, New Hampshire erected a Memorial Light at the Shrine of Our Lady of Grace in Columbia, New Hampshire;

Whereas the Shrine of Our Lady of Grace serves as a place of significance for veterans living in Coos County, for their families, and for all of those who remember the men and women who made the supreme sacrifice in battle; and

Whereas those who erected and maintain the Memorial Light at the Shrine of Our Lady of Grace wish to recognize the deeds of the men and women who died while serving in Operation Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Memorial Light at the Shrine of Our Lady of
4 Grace located in Columbia, New Hampshire, is hereby rec-
5 ognized as a memorial of national significance, and the
6 President is requested to issue a proclamation commemo-
7 rating the occasion of this recognition and saluting the
8 efforts of those individuals who have made the creation
9 and continued existence of the Memorial possible.
