Mr. McCLOSKEY introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

JOINT RESOLUTION

To designate the week of June 7, 1993, through June 14, 1993, as “National Flag Celebration Week”.

Whereas it is the obligation of each generation of Americans to instruct the next in the significance of our history and of the meaning of and the ideals embodied in our Nation’s patriotic symbols;

Whereas the flag of the United States is the principal patriotic symbol of our Nation;

Whereas the citizens of the United States already celebrate the observance of Flag Day on June 14 of each year:
Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the week beginning June 7, 1993, which culminates
4 with the observance of Flag Day on June 14, 1993, be
5 declared National Flag Celebration Week, during which
6 the Nation's school children would be encouraged to
7 discuss and study our flag, and the ideals it represents.
