## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

To provide for the issuance of a commemorative postage stamp in honor of Justice Thurgood Marshall.

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2        *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the United States Postal Service shall issue a com-  
4        memorative stamp in honor of Justice Thurgood Marshall.  
5        The stamp shall bear a likeness of Justice Marshall that  
6        shall be derived from a rendering of the image of Justice  
7        Marshall offered by Mr. Steven Johnson of Philadelphia,

- 1 Pennsylvania. The stamp shall be issued and sold for such
- 2 period as the United States Postal Service shall determine.
