## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relative to expenditures to affect Congressional, Presidential, State, and local elections.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*  
4       *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*  
5       *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all*  
6       *intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when*  
7       *ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several*

1 States within seven years after the date of its submission  
2 for ratification:

3 “ARTICLE —

4 “SECTION 1. The Congress shall have the power to  
5 set limits on expenditures by, in support of, or in opposi-  
6 tion to, all candidates in any primary, general, or other  
7 election for Federal office.

8 “SECTION 2. The States shall have the power to set  
9 limits on expenditures by, in support of, or in opposition  
10 to, all candidates in any primary, general, or other election  
11 for State or local office.”.
