## JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating the week of March 21 through 27, 1994, as “National Long-Term Care Administrators Week”.

Whereas long-term care administrators manage the day-to-day operations of over 20,000 nursing homes in the United States; and

Whereas over 1,800,000 elderly and chronically ill individuals place their well-being in the hands of the administrators and the staff they supervise: Now, therefore, be it

- 2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That March 21 through 27, 1994, is designated as “Na-

1 tional Long-Term Care Administrators Week”, and the  
2 President of the United States is authorized and requested  
3 to issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the  
4 United States to observe such week with appropriate cere-  
5 monies and activities.
