## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Designating March 20 through March 26, 1994, as "Small Family Farm Week".

Whereas the small family farmer contributes enormously to the agricultural productivity of the United States of America;

Whereas the plight of the small family farmer has been in jeopardy in recent times;

Whereas many small family farms continue to operate in the face of financial and credit difficulties;

Whereas the size and crop makeup of family farms varies from region to region in the United States of America;

Whereas a small family farm can generally be defined as having gross sales of under \$40,000, using family members as the primary component of labor; and

Whereas the small family farm represents the historical foundation of American agriculture: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the week of March 20 through March 26, 1994, is  
4       designated as “Small Family Farm Week”, and the Presi-  
5       dent is authorized and requested to issue a proclamation  
6       calling on the people of the United States to observe the  
7       week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
