## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

To establish the fourth Sunday of July as “Parents’ Day”.

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2        *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the fourth Sunday of every July shall be established  
4        as “Parents’ Day” to be recognized as a recurring, peren-  
5        nial day of commemoration.

1 **SEC. 2. RECOGNITION.**

2 All private citizens, organizations, and governmental  
3 and legislative bodies at the local, State, and Federal level  
4 are encouraged to recognize Parents' Day through procla-  
5 mations, activities, and educational efforts in furtherance  
6 of recognizing, uplifting, and supporting the role of par-  
7 ents in the rearing of their children.

1994.
