A BILL

To amend title 39, United States Code, to permit essential civilians supporting military operations, in an overseas area designated by the President, to mail at no cost letters or recorded communications of a personal nature.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR CIVILIAN PERSONAL MAIL IN**
4 **OVERSEAS MILITARY THEATERS OF OPER-**
5 **ATION.**

6 Section 3401(a)(1) of title 39, United States Code,
7 is amended—

- 1 (1) by inserting “or a civilian who otherwise is
2 authorized to use postal services at Armed Forces
3 installations and who the military theater com-
4 mander designates as in support of military oper-
5 ations,” after “a member of the Armed Forces of
6 the United States on active duty, as defined in sec-
7 tion 101 (4) and (22) of title 10,”;
- 8 (2) in subparagraph (A) by striking “by the
9 member”; and
- 10 (3) in subparagraph (B) by inserting “or civil-
11 ian” after “the member”.
