Mr. FRANK of Massachusetts introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To amend title 39, United States Code, to provide free insurance up to the value of \$100 on mail items.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) subchapter V of chapter 36 of title 39, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-
5 ing:

6 “**§ 3686. Insurance**

7 “(a) An article of mail insurable under, and mailed
8 in accordance with, regulations prescribed by the Postal
9 Service shall, without payment of any insurance fee, be

1 considered insured mail, with liability under this sub-
2 section not to exceed \$100.

3 “(b) Subsection (a) shall not prevent the purchase of
4 insurance coverage in excess of \$100 for an article of mail.

5 “(c) Regulations to carry out this section shall be pre-
6 scribed not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
7 of this section.”.

8 (b) The analysis for chapter 36 of title 39, United
9 States Code, is amended by adding after the item relating
10 to section 3685 the following:

“3686. Insurance.”.
