Mr. SANTORUM (for himself and Mr. INGLIS of South Carolina) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To impose certain restrictions on franked mass mailings by any Member of the House of Representatives who is a candidate for such office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That a newsletter or other piece of mail in a mass mailing
4 under the frank of an incumbent Representative in, or
5 Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress who
6 is a candidate for such office may not contain—

7 (1) any picture other than one photograph in
8 the masthead;

9 (2) more than 16 personal references to the in-
10 cumbent;

1 (3) any content that is not related to legislation
2 or legislative activity; or

3 (4) any personal reference to the incumbent
4 (other than in the masthead) in type greater in size
5 than 14-point type.
