## A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act and the Controlled  
Substances Import and Export Act with respect to the  
drug fentanyl.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       That—

4               (1) section 401(b) of the Controlled Substances  
5       Act (21 U.S.C. 841(b)) is amended—

6               (A) in paragraph (1)(A)(vi)—

7                       (i) by striking “400 grams” and in-  
8       serting “40 grams”; and

1 (ii) by striking “or 100 grams” and  
2 all that follows through the end of clause  
3 (vi) and inserting “(fentanyl) or any of its  
4 analogues;”; and

5 (B) in paragraph (1)(B)(vi)—

6 (i) by striking “40 grams” and insert-  
7 ing “4 grams”; and

8 (ii) by striking “or 10 grams” and all  
9 that follows through the end of clause (vi)  
10 and inserting “(fentanyl) or any of its ana-  
11 logues;”; and

12 (2) section 1010(b) of the Controlled Sub-  
13 stances Import and Export Act (21 U.S.C. 960(b))  
14 is amended—

15 (A) in paragraph (1)(F)—

16 (i) by striking “400 grams” and in-  
17 serting “40 grams”; and

18 (ii) by striking “or 100 grams” and  
19 all that follows through the end of clause  
20 (vi) and inserting “(fentanyl) or any of its  
21 analogues;”; and

22 (B) in paragraph (2)(F)—

23 (i) by striking “40 grams” and insert-  
24 ing “4 grams”; and

1                   (ii) by striking “or 10 grams” and all  
2                   that follows through the end of clause (vi)  
3                   and inserting “(fentanyl) or any of its ana-  
4                   logues;”.
