A BILL

To limit purchases of district office equipment and furnishings by a departing Member to items not needed for official use by the successor to the departing Member.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That subsection (b) of the first section of the Act entitled
4 “An Act to authorize the disposition of certain office
5 equipment and furnishings, and for other purposes” (2
6 U.S.C. 59a(b)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking out “and” at the end of para-
8 graph (1);

1 (2) by striking out the period at the end of
2 paragraph (2) and inserting in lieu thereof “; and”;
3 and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following new
5 paragraph:

6 “(3) subject to the right of the successor to the
7 Member who is leaving office or otherwise ceasing to
8 be a Member to retain the equipment or furnishings
9 for official use.”.
