Mr. DICKEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To require a 25-percent reduction in appropriations for the legislative branch of the Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION OF 25 PERCENT IN APPROPRIA-**
4 **TIONS FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF**
5 **THE GOVERNMENT.**

6 Notwithstanding any other law, or any rule or other
7 authority, the total of appropriations for the legislative
8 branch of the Government for fiscal year 1994 may not
9 exceed 75 percent of the total of appropriations for the
10 legislative branch of the Government for fiscal year 1993.

1 **SEC. 2. PRIORITY TO BE GIVEN TO ELIMINATION OF DUPLI-**
2 **CATIVE SERVICES.**

3 In carrying out section 1, the Congress shall give first
4 consideration to reductions in appropriations that may be
5 achieved by means of elimination of duplicative services
6 in congressional operations, with particular emphasis on
7 consolidation of all legal services of the House of Rep-
8 resentatives, the Senate, and the Library of Congress.
