Mr. PICKETT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Earl B. Chappell, Jr.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM TO EARL B. CHAPPELL, JR.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
5 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the
6 sum of \$53,773.23 to Earl B. Chappell, Jr., of Virginia
7 Beach, Virginia. The sum represents interest on the
8 amount erroneously deducted from the backpay paid to
9 Earl B. Chappell, Jr., in November 1974 pursuant to his
10 reinstatement to a civil service position with the United
11 States Navy and not remitted to him until February 19,
12 1986. Payment of the sum shall fully satisfy any claim

1 Earl B. Chappell, Jr., has against the United States for
2 damages relating to the amount deducted from his back-
3 pay award.

4 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEYS FEES.**

5 No amount exceeding 10 percent of the payment
6 made under section 1 shall be paid to or received by any
7 agent or attorney in consideration for services rendered
8 in connection with the payment. Any person who violates
9 this section shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be
10 subject to a fine in the amount provided under title 18,
11 United States Code.
