To make Members of Congress ineligible to participate in the Federal Employees' Retirement System.

Mr. COBLE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To make Members of Congress ineligible to participate in the Federal Employees' Retirement System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN FERS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise provided in
5 this section, effective as of the date of the enactment of
6 this Act, a Member of Congress shall be ineligible to par-
7 ticipate in the Federal Employees' Retirement System.

8 (b) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply with
9 respect to any individual who, as of the date of the enact-
10 ment of this Act, satisfies the requirements of section

1 8410 of title 5, United States Code, for being considered
2 eligible for an annuity under subchapter II of chapter 84
3 of such title.

4 (c) REFUNDS OF CONTRIBUTIONS.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Nothing in subsection (a)
6 shall prevent appropriate refunds from being made,
7 in accordance with applicable provisions of law, on
8 account of an individual's becoming ineligible to par-
9 ticipate in the Federal Employees' Retirement Sys-
10 tem as a result of the enactment of this Act.

11 (2) SPECIAL RULE.—For purposes of making
12 any refunds in accordance with paragraph (1), a
13 Member who becomes ineligible to participate in the
14 Federal Employees' Retirement System as a result
15 of the enactment of this Act shall be treated in the
16 same way as if separated from service.

17 (d) ANNUITANTS NOT AFFECTED.—Subsection (a)
18 shall not be considered to apply with respect to—

19 (1) any former Member of Congress who, as of
20 the date of the enactment of this Act, is entitled (or
21 would on proper application be entitled) to an annu-
22 ity computed, in whole or in part, by reference to
23 section 8415 of title 5, United States Code; or

24 (2) any individual who, as of the date of the en-
25 actment of this Act, is entitled (or would on proper

1 application be entitled) to an annuity as a survivor
2 of a former Member of Congress.

3 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

4 For purposes of this Act, the terms “Member of Con-
5 gress” and “Member” have the same meaning as the term
6 “Member” under section 8401(20) of title 5, United
7 States Code.
