A BILL

To amend the Federal Aviation Act of 1958 to limit the age restrictions imposed upon aircraft pilots.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AGE RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED**
4 **UPON AIRCRAFT PILOTS.**

5 Section 602(b) of the Federal Aviation Act of 1958
6 (49 U.S.C. 1422(b)) is amended by adding at the end
7 thereof the following new paragraph:

1 “(3) LIMITATION ON AGE RESTRICTIONS.—The
2 Administrator shall not, solely by reason of the age
3 of a person, if such person is less than 65 years of
4 age—

5 “(A) refuse to issue an airman certificate
6 to, or refuse to renew such certificate for, such
7 person, if such person is applying for the issu-
8 ance or renewal of such certificate in order to
9 serve or continue to serve as a pilot of an air-
10 craft; or

11 “(B) require an air carrier to terminate
12 the employment of, or refuse to employ, such
13 person as a pilot on an aircraft of such air car-
14 rier.”.
