Mr. MCCANDLESS (for himself, Mr. PARKER, Mr. SOLOMON, Mr. PAXON, Mr. DORNAN, and Mr. LAZIO) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to the use and sale of military medals and decorations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 704 of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) by inserting “(a)” before “Whoever”;

6 (2) by striking “not more than \$250” and in-
7 serting “under this title”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(b)(1) If the decoration or medal involved in an of-
10 fense under subsection (a) of this section is a Congres-

1 sional Medal of Honor, in lieu of the punishment provided
2 in such subsection the offender shall be fined under this
3 title or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

4 “(2) As used in subsection (a) of this section with
5 respect to a Congressional Medal of Honor, the term ‘sells’
6 includes trades, barters, or exchanges for anything of
7 value.

8 “(3) As used in this subsection, the term ‘Congres-
9 sional Medal of Honor’ is a medal awarded under section
10 3741 of title 10.”
