Mr. DUNCAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to eliminate maximum-age entry requirements for Federal law enforcement officers and firefighters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 3307 of title 5, United States Code, is
4 amended by striking subsections (c) through (e) and in-
5 serting the following:

6 “(c) The Secretary of the Interior may fix a mini-
7 mum-age requirement for original appointment to the
8 United States Park Police.

9 “(d) The head of an agency may fix a minimum-age
10 requirement for original appointment to a position within

1 such agency as a law enforcement officer or firefighter,
2 as defined under section 8331.

3 “(e) The head of an agency may fix a minimum-age
4 requirement for original appointment to a position within
5 such agency as a law enforcement officer or firefighter,
6 as defined under section 8401.”.
