1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2 The Federal building to be constructed between Gay
3 and Market Streets and Cumberland and Church Avenues
4 in Knoxville, Tennessee, shall be known and designated
5 as the “Howard H. Baker, Jr. United States Courthouse”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
9 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
10 a reference to the “Howard H. Baker, Jr. United States
11 Courthouse”.
