Mr. SWIFT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

Relating to customs fees charged with respect to certain commercial truck arrivals in Whatcom County, Washington.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM FEE.**

4 Section 13031(b)(2) of the Consolidated Omnibus
5 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (19 U.S.C. 58c(b)(2))
6 is amended—

7 (1) by inserting “(A)” after “(2)”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(B) No fee may be charged under subsection (a)(2)
10 for the arrival of a commercial truck in any port of entry

1 in Whatcom County, Washington, in the course of a
2 round-trip journey between Point Roberts, Washington,
3 and any other place in the State of Washington if—

4 “(i) Point Roberts, Washington, is either the
5 place from which the journey originates or the re-
6 turn trip starts; and

7 “(ii) no stops are made for commercial pur-
8 poses during each Canadian segment of the jour-
9 ney.”.

10 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 The amendments made by section 1 apply with re-
12 spect to arrivals that are made in the course of journeys
13 described in section 1 and that occur on or after the 15th
14 day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
