# H. R. 1721

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to grant a special use permit.

Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on Natural Resources

---

## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to grant a special  
use permit.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE PERMIT.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Sec-  
5 retary of the Interior is authorized to issue a special use  
6 permit allowing the installation, operation, and mainte-  
7 nance of a communications shelter and associated anten-  
8 nas within the boundaries of Katmai National Park and  
9 Preserve at Cape Gull.

10 **SEC. 2. CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS.**

11 Any permit issued under this Act shall—

1           (1) be in effect for at least five years but no  
2 more than twenty five years;

3           (2) not be transferrable except by permission of  
4 the Secretary of the Interior;

5           (3) encompass no more than one quarter acre  
6 of land adjacent to the existing Federal communica-  
7 tions facilities;

8           (4) allow reasonable access, including by use of  
9 aircraft, boat, or other motorized vehicles, to the  
10 permit holder for the purpose of construction, repair,  
11 and maintenance;

12           (5) require the permit holder to avoid unreason-  
13 able disturbance to fish and wildlife;

14           (6) require, to the extent practicable, that any  
15 structures blend into the natural environment; and

16           (7) require the permit holder to dismantle and  
17 remove all structures upon expiration of the permit.

18 **SEC. 3. FEES.**

19       The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to charge  
20 reasonable fees sufficient to cover the cost of processing  
21 the permit application and for use of Federal land.
