A BILL

Relating to the tariff treatment of paintings imported for the use of any public library, any other public institution, or any nonprofit institution established for educational, scientific, literary, or philosophical purposes, or for the encouragement of the fine arts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAINTINGS IMPORTED FOR USE BY CERTAIN**
4 **PUBLIC OR NONPROFIT INSTITUTIONS.**

5 Subchapter X of chapter 98 of the Harmonized Tariff
6 Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting in
7 numerical sequence the following new subheading, with the

1 article description having the same degree of indentation
2 as the article description in subheading 9810.00.40:

“ | 9810.00.42 | Paintings | Free | | Free | ”.

3 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

4 The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with
5 respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse
6 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date
7 of the enactment of this Act.
