Mr. BILIRAKIS (for himself, Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas, and Mr. EVERETT) introduced the following bill; which was referred jointly to the Committees on Appropriations and Rules

A BILL

To modify the provision of law which provides a permanent appropriation for the compensation of Members of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That this Act may be cited as the “Congressional Pay For
4 Performance Act”.

5 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF PERMANENT APPROPRIA-**
6 **TION FOR MEMBERS’ PAY.**

7 Subsection (c) of section 130 of the joint resolution
8 entitled “Joint resolution making continuing appropria-
9 tions for the fiscal year 1982, and for other purposes”

1 (Public Law 97-51; 2 U.S.C. 31 note) is amended by
2 striking out “Effective” and by inserting “(1) Except to
3 the extent provided by paragraph (2), effective” and by
4 inserting at the end the following new paragraph:

5 “(2) If Congress has not passed all general appro-
6 priation bills before the beginning of a fiscal year, then
7 the appropriation contained in paragraph (1) shall not be
8 effective with respect to such fiscal year.”.

9 **SEC. 2. CONSIDERATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH AP-**
10 **PROPRIATION.**

11 It shall not be in order in either the House of Rep-
12 resentatives or the Senate to consider the general appro-
13 priation bill making appropriations for the legislative
14 branch for any fiscal year unless and until other general
15 appropriation bills for such fiscal year have been presented
16 to the President for signature under section 7 of Article
17 I of the Constitution.
