## A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1994 for the Federal Maritime Commission, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Federal Maritime  
5        Commission Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1994”.

6        **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7        There is authorized to be appropriated to the Federal  
8        Maritime Commission \$19,450,000 for fiscal year 1994.

1 **SEC. 3. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NONPERFORM-**  
2 **ANCE OF VOYAGES.**

3 Section 3(b) of Public Law 89-777 (46 App. U.S.C.  
4 817e(b)) is amended by striking “and such bond or other  
5 security shall be in an amount paid equal to the estimated  
6 total revenue for the particular transportation.” and in-  
7 serting a period.
