Mr. RAMSTAD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on photoreceptors and assemblies containing photoreceptors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PHOTORECEPTORS AND ASSEMBLIES.**

4 Heading 9902.90.90 of the Harmonized Tariff
5 Schedule of the United States is amended—

6 (1) by striking the article description and in-
7 serting “Photoreceptors or assemblies containing
8 photoreceptors of electrostatic copying machines,
9 which machines operate by reproducing the original

1 image via an intermediate (provided for in sub-
2 heading 9009.90.00).”, and

3 (2) by striking “12/31/92” and inserting “12/
4 31/96”.

5 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by section
7 1 applies with respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.

10 (b) RETROACTIVE PROVISION.—Notwithstanding sec-
11 tion 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision
12 of law to the contrary, upon a request filed with the appro-
13 priate customs officer before the 90th day after the date
14 of the enactment of this Act, any entry or withdrawal from
15 warehouse for consumption of goods to which the amend-
16 ment made by section 1 applies and that was made—

17 (1) after December 31, 1992; and

18 (2) before the 15th day after the date of the en-
19 actment of this Act;

20 and with respect to which there would have been no duty
21 or a lower duty if the amendment made by section 1 had
22 applied to such entry or withdrawal, shall be liquidated
23 or reliquidated as though such entry or withdrawal had
24 occurred on such 15th day.
