AMENDMENTS

In the Senate of the United States,

March 17 (legislative day, February 22), 1994.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 2139) entitled “An Act to amend title 44, United States Code, to authorize appropriations for the National Historical Publications and Records Commission”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 ***SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.***

2 *Section 2504(f)(1) of title 44, United States Code, is*
3 *amended—*

4 *(1) in subparagraph (B), by striking out “and”*
5 *after the semicolon;*

6 *(2) in subparagraph (C), by striking out the pe-*
7 *riod and inserting in lieu thereof a semicolon; and*

8 *(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-*
9 *paragraphs:*

10 *“(D) \$6,000,000 for fiscal year 1994;*

11 *“(E) \$7,000,000 for fiscal year 1995;*

12 *“(F) \$8,000,000 for fiscal year 1996; and*

13 *“(G) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1997.”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “An Act to authorize appropriations for the National Historical Publications and Records Commission for fiscal years 1994, 1995, 1996, and 1997.”.
