## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for women an increase in the availability of preventive health services from certain grantees under such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Women’s Preventive  
5 Health Amendments of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM**  
2 **OF GRANTS FOR ADDITIONAL PREVENTIVE**  
3 **HEALTH SERVICES FOR WOMEN.**

4 Title XV of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.  
5 300k et seq.) is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating section 1509 as section  
7 1510; and

8 (2) by inserting after section 1508 the following  
9 section:

10 **“SEC. 1509. SUPPLEMENTAL GRANTS FOR ADDITIONAL**  
11 **PREVENTIVE HEALTH SERVICES.**

12 “(a) DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS.—In the case of  
13 States receiving grants under section 1501, the Secretary,  
14 acting through the Director of the Centers for Disease  
15 Control and Prevention, may make grants to not more  
16 than 3 such States to carry out demonstration projects  
17 for the purpose of—

18 “(1) providing to women preventive health serv-  
19 ices, and health promotion services, in addition to  
20 the services authorized in such section;

21 “(2) providing appropriate referrals for medical  
22 treatment of women receiving services pursuant to  
23 paragraph (1) and ensuring, to the extent prac-  
24 ticable, the provision of appropriate follow-up serv-  
25 ices; and

1           “(3) evaluating activities conducted under para-  
2           graphs (1) and (2) through appropriate surveillance  
3           or program-monitoring activities.

4           “(b) STATUS AS PARTICIPANT IN PROGRAM REGARD-  
5           ING BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER.—The Secretary  
6           may not make a grant under subsection (a) unless the  
7           State involved agrees that services under the grant will  
8           be provided only through entities that are screening  
9           women for breast or cervical cancer pursuant to a grant  
10          under section 1501.

11          “(c) REQUIREMENTS REGARDING MATCHING FUNDS,  
12          FEES FOR SERVICES, AND CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS.—  
13          The Secretary may not make a grant under subsection (a)  
14          unless the State involved agrees that section 1502, and  
15          sections 1504 through 1506, apply to a grant under sub-  
16          section (a) to the same extent and in the same manner  
17          as such sections apply to a grant under section 1501.

18          “(d) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE; SUPPLIES AND SERV-  
19          ICES IN LIEU OF GRANT FUNDS.—Section 1507 applies  
20          to a grant under subsection (a) to the same extent and  
21          in the same manner as such section applies to a grant  
22          under section 1501.

23          “(e) EVALUATIONS AND REPORTS.—Section 1508  
24          applies to a grant under subsection (a) to the same extent

1 and in the same manner as such section applies to a grant  
2 under section 1501.”.

3 **SEC. 3. FUNDING.**

4 Section 1510 of the Public Health Service Act, as re-  
5 designated by section 2 of this Act, is amended to read  
6 as follows:

7 **“SEC. 1510. FUNDING.**

8 “(a) PROGRAM REGARDING BREAST AND CERVICAL  
9 CANCER.—

10 “(1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

11 For the purpose of carrying out this title other than  
12 section 1509, there are authorized to be appro-  
13 priated such sums as may be necessary for fiscal  
14 year 1994.

15 “(2) SET-ASIDE FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE  
16 AND PROVISION OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES.—Of  
17 the amounts appropriated under paragraph (1) for  
18 a fiscal year, the Secretary shall reserve not more  
19 than 20 percent for carrying out section 1507.

20 “(b) PROGRAM REGARDING ADDITIONAL PREVEN-  
21 TIVE HEALTH SERVICES.—

22 “(1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

23 Subject to paragraph (2), for the purpose of carry-  
24 ing out section 1509, there are authorized to be ap-

1       appropriated such sums as may be necessary for each  
2       of the fiscal years 1994 through 1996.

3               “(2) LIMITATION REGARDING FUNDING WITH  
4       RESPECT TO BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER.—The  
5       authorization of appropriations established in para-  
6       graph (1) is not effective for a fiscal year unless the  
7       amount appropriated under subsection (a)(1) for the  
8       fiscal year equals or exceeds the amount appro-  
9       priated under such subsection for the preceding fis-  
10      cal year.”.
