## A BILL

To suspend until January 1, 1995, the duty on chromotropic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHROMOTROPIC ACID.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

9902.31.12	1,8-Dihydroxy-naphthalene-3, 6-disulfonic acid, also known as Chromotropic Acid (CAS No. 129-96-4) (provided for in sub-heading 2908.20.20) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/94	..

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

2       The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with  
3 respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse  
4 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date  
5 of the enactment of this Act.
