3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING SUSPENSION OF**

4 **DUTY ON CHEMICAL INTERMEDIATE.**

5 Heading 9902.30.96 of the Harmonized Tariff
6 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking
7 “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/95”.

8 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

9 The amendment made by section 1 applies with re-
10 spect to articles entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for

1 consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date of
2 the enactment of this Act.
