For the relief of Gorsha Michaelovich Sur.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN NATURALIZATION RE-**
4 **QUIREMENTS FOR GORSHA MICHAELOVICH**
5 **SUR.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the inability of
7 Gorsha Michaelovich Sur to meet the requirements of sec-
8 tion 316 of the Immigration and Nationality Act that re-
9 late to residence and physical presence in the United
10 States, he shall be deemed eligible for naturalization upon
11 the filing of the appropriate application if otherwise quali-
12 fied for naturalization under such Act.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
3 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 2
4 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
