To suspend for a 3-year period the duty on omega-dodecalactam.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY DUTY SUSPENSION FOR IM-**
4 **PORTED OMEGA-DODECALACTAM.**

5 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
6 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
7 in numerical sequence the following new heading:
