To authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1994 and 1995 to carry out the National Foundation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965, and the Museum Services Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Arts, Humanities, and
5 Museums Amendments of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL FOUNDATION ON**
7 **THE ARTS AND THE HUMANITIES ACT OF**
8 **1965.**

9 (a) MODIFICATION OF LIMITATION ON USE OF FED-
10 ERAL FUNDS.—Section 5(g) of the National Foundation
11 on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
12 954(g)) is amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (4)(C)—

14 (A) by inserting “(i)” after “(C)”, and

15 (B) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(ii) Notwithstanding any other provision of this sub-
2 section, the amount allotted to a State for the current fis-
3 cal year under this subsection may not be greater than
4 the amount so allotted to such State for the preceding fis-
5 cal year if—

6 “(I) the amount of State funds to be expended
7 for such current fiscal year to carry out this sub-
8 section is less than the average annual amount ex-
9 pended by such State during the most recent preced-
10 ing period of 3 fiscal years to carry out this sub-
11 section; and

12 “(II) the rate of the reduction in the amount of
13 State funds exceeds the rate of reduction in the ag-
14 gregate of all general fund expenditures to be made
15 by the State in such current fiscal year.”, and

16 (2) in paragraph (5)—

17 (A) by striking “(5) All” and inserting

18 “(5)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph

19 (B), all”, and

20 (B) by adding at the end the following:

21 “(B) All amounts allotted under paragraph (3) that
22 are not made available to a State as a result of the oper-
23 ation of subsection (g)(4)(C)(ii) shall be allotted to the
24 remaining States in equal amounts.”.

1 (b) FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR PROGRAM GRANTS.—
2 Section 11(a)(1) of the National Foundation on the Arts
3 and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 960(a)(1))
4 is amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

6 (i) in clause (i) by striking
7 “\$125,800,000” and all that follows through
8 “1993”, and inserting “\$119,985,000 for fiscal
9 year 1994 and such sums as may be necessary
10 for fiscal year 1995”,

11 (ii) by amending clause (ii) to read as fol-
12 lows:

13 “(ii) Not less than 27.5 percent of the amount appro-
14 priated under clause (i) for each of the fiscal years 1994
15 and 1995 shall be for carrying out section 5(g).”,

16 (iii) in the first sentence of clause (iii) by
17 striking “For” and all that follows through
18 “year;” the last place it appears, and inserting
19 “Not less than 7.5 percent of the amount ap-
20 propriated under clause (i) for each of the fiscal
21 years 1994 and 1995”, and

22 (2) in the first sentence of subparagraph (B) by
23 striking “\$119,900,000” and all that follows
24 through “1993”, and inserting “\$130,573,000 for

1 fiscal year 1994 and such sums as may be necessary
2 for fiscal year 1995”.

3 (c) FUNDS AUTHORIZED TO MATCH NON-FEDERAL
4 FUNDS RECEIVED.—Section 11(a) of the National Foun-
5 dation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20
6 U.S.C. 960(a)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (2)—

8 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

9 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
10 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

11 (ii) by striking “\$13,000,000” and all
12 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
13 “\$16,955,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
14 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 1995”,

16 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

17 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
18 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

19 (ii) by striking “\$12,000,000” and all
20 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
21 “\$11,963,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
22 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
23 year 1995”,

24 (2) in paragraph (3)—

25 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
2 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

3 (ii) by striking “\$15,000,000” and all
4 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
5 “\$13,187,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
6 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 1995”, and

8 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

9 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
10 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

11 (ii) by striking “\$15,150,000” and all
12 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
13 “\$14,228,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
14 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 1995”, and

16 (3) in the last sentence of paragraph (4) by
17 striking “section 5(l)(2)” and inserting “section
18 5(p)(2)”.

19 (d) FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR ADMINISTRATION OF
20 PROGRAMS OF THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENTS.—Section
21 11(c) of the National Foundation on the Arts and the Hu-
22 manities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 960(c)) is amended—

23 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “\$21,200,000”
24 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting

1 “\$24,466,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as
2 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”, and

3 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “\$17,950,000”
4 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting
5 “\$20,727,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as
6 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”.

7 (e) LIMITATIONS ON TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS AU-
8 THORIZED.—Section 11(d) of the National Foundation on
9 the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
10 960(d)) is amended—

11 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “exceed” and
12 all that follows through the period at the end, and
13 inserting “exceed \$174,593,000 for fiscal year
14 1994.”, and

15 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “exceed” and
16 all that follows through the period at the end, and
17 inserting “exceed \$177,491,000 for fiscal year
18 1994.”.

19 (f) INVESTIGATION AND REPORT.—Not later than
20 September 30, 1995, the Chairperson of the National En-
21 dowment for the Arts shall—

22 (1) conduct an investigation of State compli-
23 ance with section 5(g)(4)(C)(i) of the National
24 Foundation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of
25 1965 (20 U.S.C. 954(g)(4)(C)(i)), and

1 (2) submit to the Speaker of the House of Rep-
2 representatives and the President pro tempore, a report
3 containing—

4 (A) the results of such investigation, and

5 (B) any information and recommendations
6 as the Chairperson considers to be appropriate.

7 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO THE MUSEUM SERVICES ACT.**

8 Section 209 of the Museum Services Act (20 U.S.C.
9 967) is amended—

10 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “\$24,000,000”
11 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting
12 “\$28,777,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as
13 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”, and

14 (2) in subsection (d) by striking “1993” and in-
15 serting “1995”.
