A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1994 and 1995 to carry out the National Foundation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965, and the Museum Services Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Arts, Humanities, and
3 Museums Amendments of 1993”.

4 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL FOUNDATION ON**
5 **THE ARTS AND THE HUMANITIES ACT OF**
6 **1965.**

7 (a) FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR PROGRAM GRANTS.—
8 Section 11(a)(1) of the National Foundation on the Arts
9 and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 960(a)(1))
10 is amended—

11 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

12 (i) in clause (i) by striking
13 “\$125,800,000” and all that follows through
14 “1993”, and inserting “\$119,985,000 for fiscal
15 year 1994 and such sums as may be necessary
16 for fiscal year 1995”,

17 (ii) by amending clause (ii) to read as fol-
18 lows:

19 “(ii) Not less than 27.5 percent of the amount appro-
20 priated under clause (i) for each of the fiscal years 1994
21 and 1995 shall be for carrying out section 5(g).”.

22 (iii) in the first sentence of clause (iii) by
23 striking “For” and all that follows through
24 “year;” the last place it appears, and inserting
25 “Not less than 7.5 percent of the amount ap-

1 appropriated under clause (i) for each of the fiscal
2 years 1994 and 1995”, and

3 (2) in the first sentence of subparagraph (B) by
4 striking “\$119,900,000” and all that follows
5 through “1993”, and inserting “\$130,573,000 for
6 fiscal year 1994 and such sums as may be necessary
7 for fiscal year 1995”.

8 (b) FUNDS AUTHORIZED TO MATCH NON-FEDERAL
9 FUNDS RECEIVED.—Section 11(a) of the National Foun-
10 dation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20
11 U.S.C. 960(a)) is amended—

12 (1) in paragraph (2)—

13 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

14 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
15 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

16 (ii) by striking “\$13,000,000” and all
17 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
18 “\$16,955,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
19 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 1995”,

21 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

22 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
23 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

24 (ii) by striking “\$12,000,000” and all
25 that follows through “1993”, and inserting

1 “\$11,963,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
2 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
3 year 1995”,

4 (2) in paragraph (3)—

5 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

6 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
7 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

8 (ii) by striking “\$15,000,000” and all
9 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
10 “\$13,187,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
11 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 1995”, and

13 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

14 (i) by striking “1993” the first place
15 it appears and inserting “1995”, and

16 (ii) by striking “\$15,150,000” and all
17 that follows through “1993”, and inserting
18 “\$14,228,000 for fiscal year 1994 and
19 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 1995”, and

21 (3) in the last sentence of paragraph (4) by
22 striking “section 5(l)(2)” and inserting “section
23 5(p)(2)”.

24 (c) FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR ADMINISTRATION OF
25 PROGRAMS OF THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENTS.—Section

1 11(c) of the National Foundation on the Arts and the Hu-
2 manities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 960(c)) is amended—

3 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “\$21,200,000”
4 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting
5 “\$24,466,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as
6 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”, and

7 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “\$17,950,000”
8 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting
9 “\$20,727,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as
10 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”.

11 (d) LIMITATIONS ON TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS AU-
12 THORIZED.—Section 11(d) of the National Foundation on
13 the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
14 960(d)) is amended—

15 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “exceed” and
16 all that follows through the period at the end, and
17 inserting “exceed \$174,593,000 for fiscal year
18 1994.”, and

19 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “exceed” and
20 all that follows through the period at the end, and
21 inserting “exceed \$177,491,000 for fiscal year
22 1994.”.

23 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO THE MUSEUM SERVICES ACT.**

24 Section 209 of the Museum Services Act (20 U.S.C.
25 967) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “\$24,000,000”
2 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting
3 “\$28,777,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as
4 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”, and
5 (2) in subsection (d) by striking “1993” and in-
6 serting “1995”.
