Mr. CONYERS introduced the following bill; which was referred jointly to the Committees on Appropriations and Government Operations

A BILL

To make supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 1993 for the summer jobs program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cold War Funds for
5 Youth Summer Jobs Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 The following sums are appropriated, out of any
8 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pro-
9 vide supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 1993:

1 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR
2 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ADMINISTRATION
3 TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

4 For an additional amount for “Training and employ-
5 ment services” for activities under part B of title II of
6 the Job Training Partnership Act (29 U.S.C. 1630 et
7 seq.), \$4,000,000,000.

8 **SEC. 3. DESIGNATION AS DEFENSE SPENDING.**

9 The new budget authority and outlays for fiscal year
10 1993 resulting from the amount made available in section
11 2 shall be counted against the defense category of the dis-
12 cretionary spending limits (as defined in section 601(a)(2)
13 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974) for purposes
14 of part C of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit
15 Control Act of 1985, thereby—

16 (1) utilizing for domestic purposes a portion of
17 the approximately \$14 billion in budget authority re-
18 maining under the \$290 billion discretionary spend-
19 ing limit applicable for the defense category for fis-
20 cal year 1993; and

21 (2) providing an exemption from reduction in
22 the funds available for other domestic discretionary
23 programs.
