## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide that future increases in the monthly amount paid by the State of New York to blind disabled veterans shall be excluded from the determination of annual income for purposes of payment of pension by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS FROM IN-**  
2 **COME DETERMINATION FOR PENSION PUR-**  
3 **POSES.**

4 Section 1503 of title 38, United States Code, is  
5 amended—

6 (1) by striking out “and” at the end of para-  
7 graph (9);

8 (2) by striking out the period at the end of  
9 paragraph (10) and inserting in lieu thereof  
10 “, and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following new  
12 paragraph:

13 “(11) amounts equal to amounts paid to a vet-  
14 eran by the State of New York under a program of  
15 that State to make monthly payments to qualifying  
16 veterans who are blind and totally disabled, but only  
17 to the extent that such amounts are attributable to  
18 any increase in the monthly amount of such pay-  
19 ments that is provided after the date of enactment  
20 of this paragraph.”.
