1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN CHEMICALS.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
6 in numerical sequence the following new headings:
