A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Independent Safety
3 Board Act Amendments of 1993”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

5 Section 309(a) of the Independent Safety Board Act
6 of 1974 (49 U.S.C. App. 1907(a)) is amended by adding
7 at the end the following new sentence: “There are author-
8 ized to be appropriated for the purposes of this Act not
9 to exceed \$37,580,000 for the fiscal year ending Septem-
10 ber 30, 1994, \$44,000,000 for the fiscal year ending Sep-
11 tember 30, 1995, and \$45,100,000 for the fiscal year end-
12 ing September 30, 1996; such sums to remain available
13 until expended.”.
