Mr. DURBIN (for himself, Mr. EVANS, and Mr. VOLKMER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works and Transportation

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to provide shoreline projects to maintain certain flood control projects on the Mississippi and Iowa Rivers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.**

4 The Secretary of the Army may undertake such
5 measures as the Secretary determines are appropriate to
6 provide shoreline protection to maintain the integrity of
7 the following flood control projects at the specified river
8 miles:

1 (1) Iowa River-Flint Creek Levee District Num-
2 ber 16, Iowa, at miles 406.25, 420.5, and 424.8 of
3 the Mississippi River.

4 (2) Gregory Drainage District, Missouri, at
5 miles 352 through 353 of the Mississippi River.

6 (3) Lima Lake Drainage District, Illinois, at
7 miles 345.0 through 345.3 of the Mississippi River.

8 (4) Indian Grave Drainage District, Illinois, at
9 mile 336 of the Mississippi River.

10 (5) Bay Island Drainage District, Illinois, at
11 miles 437 through 439 and mile 440 of the Mis-
12 sissippi River.

13 (6) Muscatine Island Levee Drainage District,
14 Iowa, at miles 442 through 443 of the Mississippi
15 River.

16 (7) South River Drainage District, Missouri, at
17 mile 317 of the Mississippi River.

18 (8) Sny Island Levee and Drainage District, Il-
19 linois, at miles 273.8, 274.9 through 275.2, 275.8
20 through 276, 277.8 through 278.3, 278.9, 306.9,
21 312.3 through 312.8, and 313 of the Mississippi
22 River.

23 (9) Iowa River-Flint Creek Levee, Iowa, at
24 miles 0 through 7.2 of the Iowa River.

1 **SEC. 2. CONTINUATION OF LOCAL RESPONSIBILITIES.**

2 This Act shall not relieve the sponsor of a project
3 referred to in section 1 from its responsibilities for cost
4 sharing pursuant to the Water Resources Development
5 Act of 1986, including local assurances to operate and
6 maintain structure and protective works associated with
7 the project in accordance with the requirements of the
8 Secretary of the Army.

9 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10 There is authorized to be appropriated \$1,500,000
11 for each of fiscal years 1994, 1995, 1996, and 1997 to
12 carry out this Act.

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
