Mr. APPLGATE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey to the
State of Ohio the Senecaville National Fish Hatchery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF SENECAVILLE NATIONAL**

4 **FISH HATCHERY.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—Notwithstanding
6 any other provision of law and within 180 days after the
7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the
8 Interior shall convey to the State of Ohio without reim-
9 bursement all right, title, and interest of the United States

1 in and to the property known as the Senecaville National
2 Fish Hatchery, located in Senecaville, Ohio, including—

3 (1) all easements and water rights relating to
4 that property, and

5 (2) all land, improvements, and related personal
6 property comprising that hatchery.

7 (b) USE OF PROPERTY.—All property and interests
8 conveyed under this section shall be used by the Ohio De-
9 partment of Natural Resources for the Ohio fishery re-
10 sources management program.

11 (c) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—All right, title, and
12 interest in and to all property and interests conveyed
13 under this section shall revert to the United States on any
14 date on which any of the property or interests are used
15 other than for the Ohio fishery resources management
16 program.
