Mr. DURBIN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to establish an Abraham Lincoln Research and Interpretive Center.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ABRAHAM LINCOLN INTERPRETIVE CENTER.**

4 The Act entitled "An Act to authorize the Secretary  
5 of the Interior to establish the Lincoln Home National  
6 Historic Site in the State of Illinois, and for other pur-  
7 poses", approved August 18, 1971 (85 Stat. 347), is  
8 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

1 **“SEC. 4. ABRAHAM LINCOLN INTERPRETIVE CENTER.**

2       “(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—In order to provide for the  
3 education, inspiration and benefit of the American people,  
4 and to further the interpretation of the life and contribu-  
5 tions of Abraham Lincoln and his times, the Secretary of  
6 the Interior is authorized to establish at or near the Lin-  
7 coln Home National Historic Site an interpretive center  
8 which shall be known as the Abraham Lincoln Interpretive  
9 Center (hereafter in this section referred to as the ‘cen-  
10 ter’). The center shall be added to and administered as  
11 part of the Lincoln Home National Historic Site. Upon  
12 establishment of the center, the boundary of the Lincoln  
13 Home National Historic Site is hereby modified to include  
14 the center.

15       “(b) ACQUISITION OF LAND.—For the purposes of  
16 this section, the Secretary may acquire land or interests  
17 in land near the Lincoln Home National Historic Site by  
18 donation, purchase with donated or appropriated funds,  
19 or exchange. Lands or interests therein owned by the  
20 State of Illinois or any political subdivision thereof may  
21 be acquired only by donation.

22       “(c) CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF FACILITIES.—In carrying out this section, the  
23 Secretary is authorized to construct, operate, and main-  
24 tain a facility, including an exhibit area, in order to pre-  
25 serve and make available materials related to the life of

1 Abraham Lincoln and to provide interpretive and edu-  
2 cational services which communicate the meaning of the  
3 life of Abraham Lincoln.

4 “(d) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—In carrying out  
5 this section, the Secretary may enter into cooperative  
6 agreements with (1) appropriate Federal agencies and the  
7 State of Illinois, or any political subdivision thereof, for  
8 the interpretation of resources at the center, and (2) with  
9 the owners of documents and artifacts of historical or cul-  
10 tural significance as determined by the Secretary.

11 “(e) DOCUMENTS AND ARTIFACTS.—In carrying out  
12 this section, the Secretary may acquire by purchase with  
13 donated funds, exchange, loan, or donation documents and  
14 artifacts related to the purposes of the center for display  
15 at the center.

16 “(f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In addi-  
17 tion to amounts authorized to be appropriated by section  
18 3, there is authorized to be appropriated not more than  
19 \$18,000,000 to carry out this section.”.
