Mr. MINGE (for himself, Mr. GRANDY, and Ms. DANNER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

## A BILL

To provide for the delayed repayment to the Government of advance deficiency payments received by producers who are prevented from planting a crop due to damaging weather or related condition.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That effective only for the 1993 crops of wheat, feed  
4       grains, upland cotton, and rice, if the Secretary deter-  
5       mines that any portion of the advance deficiency payment  
6       made to a producer for the crop under section 114 of the  
7       Agricultural Act of 1949 (7 U.S.C. 1445j) must be re-  
8       funded, such refund shall not be required prior to April

1 1, 1994 for that portion of the crop that is prevented from  
2 being planted due to damaging weather or related condi-  
3 tion, as such terms are defined in section 2251 of the  
4 Food, Agriculture, Conservation, and Trade Act of 1990  
5 (7 U.S.C. 1410 note).
