Mr. MINGE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

A BILL

To forgive the repayment to the Government of advance deficiency payments received by producers who are prevented from planting a crop due to damaging weather or related condition.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That effective only for the 1993 crops of wheat, feed
4 grains, upland cotton, and rice, sections 114(a)(2) (G),
5 (H), and (I) of the Agricultural Act of 1949 (7 U.S.C.
6 1445j(a)(2) (G), (H), and (I)) shall not apply to any ad-
7 vance deficiency payment made to a producer with respect
8 to that portion of the crop that is prevented from being

1 planted due to damaging weather or related condition, as
2 such terms are defined in section 2251 of the Food, Agri-
3 culture, Conservation, and Trade Act of 1990 (7 U.S.C.
4 1401 note).
