Mr. APPLGATE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works and Transportation

A BILL

To direct the Administrator of General Services to design, and acquire a site for, a Federal building to be constructed in Steubenville, Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGN AND SITE ACQUISITION FOR FEDERAL**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of General
6 Services shall design, and acquire a site for, a Federal
7 building to be constructed in Steubenville, Ohio.

8 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—The Federal building to be de-
9 signed under subsection (a) shall include, at a minimum,
10 the following:

1 (1) A courtroom and other facilities to house
2 the United States District Court for the Southern
3 District of Ohio.

4 (2) A courtroom and other facilities to house a
5 bankruptcy court.

6 (3) A courtroom and other facilities to house an
7 Administrative Law Judge.

8 (4) Office space and other facilities to house a
9 United States Attorneys' office.

10 (5) Office space and other facilities sufficient to
11 meet the reasonably foreseeable needs of Govern-
12 ment officers and employees in the locality.

13 (6) Adequate parking facilities.

14 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

15 There is authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year
16 1994—

17 (1) such sums as may be necessary to design
18 the Federal building described in section 1; and

19 (2) \$500,000 to acquire a site for such Federal
20 building.
