## A BILL

To freeze domestic discretionary spending for fiscal years  
1994 and 1995 at fiscal year 1993 levels.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Domestic Spending  
5 Freeze Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. SPENDING FREEZE FOR FISCAL YEARS 1994 AND**

7 **1995.**

8 (a) SPENDING FREEZE.—The spending limits set  
9 forth in section 601(a)(2) of the Congressional Budget Act  
10 of 1974 for the domestic category with respect to fiscal

1 years 1994 and 1995 shall not exceed the limits provided  
2 for fiscal year 1993.

3 (b) ENFORCEMENT.—The limits on domestic spend-  
4 ing provided in this Act shall be enforced as provided in  
5 the Budget Enforcement Act of 1990 and the amendments  
6 made by such Act, except that for purposes of fiscal years  
7 1994 and 1995 the discretionary spending limit shall be  
8 enforced as provided for fiscal year 1993.
