## A BILL

To amend the Act of September 30, 1950, to provide that certain lands administered by the National Forest Service shall be deemed to have fulfilled certain requirements relating to Federal acquisition of real property.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE ACT OF SEPTEMBER 30,**

4 **1950.**

5 Section 2 of the Act of September 30, 1950 (Public  
6 Law 874, 81st Congress; 20 U.S.C. 237) is amended by  
7 adding at the end the following new subsection:

1       “(g) Beginning with the fiscal year 1994, any school  
2 district which, as demonstrated by written evidence from  
3 the National Forest Service or the Department of the In-  
4 terior satisfactory to the Secretary, contains land adminis-  
5 tered by the National Forest Service consisting of the Buf-  
6 falo Gap, the Fort Pierre, or the Grand River National  
7 Grasslands shall be deemed to have met the requirements  
8 of subsection (a)(1)(C).”.
