3 **SECTION 1. HIGHWAY SIGN FOR LIVING HERITAGE MU-**
4 **SEUM, McMINN COUNTY, TENNESSEE.**

5 (a) GRANT.—The Secretary of Transportation shall
6 make a grant to the State of Tennessee for the purpose
7 of erecting a highway sign on Interstate Route 75 at Exit

1 49 to inform motorists of the location of the Living Herit-
2 age Museum in McMinn County, Tennessee.

3 (b) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
4 of erecting the highway sign described in subsection (a)
5 shall be 100 percent.
