3 **SECTION 1. HIGHWAY SIGN FOR BLOUNT MANSION, KNOX-**
4 **VILLE, TENNESSEE.**

5 (a) GRANT.—The Secretary of Transportation shall
6 make a grant to the State of Tennessee for the purpose
7 of erecting a highway sign to inform motorists of the loca-
8 tion of Blount Mansion in Knoxville, Tennessee.

1 (b) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
2 of erecting the highway sign described in subsection (a)
3 shall be 100 percent.
