A BILL

To delay the effective date of certain proposed amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “The Delayed Effective
5 Date of Certain Amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil
6 Procedure Act of 1993”.

7 **SEC. 2. DELAY THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF CERTAIN AMEND-**
8 **MENTS TO THE RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE.**

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
10 amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure which

1 were adopted by the Supreme Court of the United States
2 and submitted to the Congress on April 22, 1993, shall
3 have no force or effect until July 1, 1996.
