A BILL

To provide for a national advisory referendum on an amendment to the Constitution to limit the terms of Representatives and Senators.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON LIMIT-**
4 **ING THE TERMS OF REPRESENTATIVES AND**
5 **SENATORS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Each State shall include on the
7 general election ballot for the year 1994 an advisory ref-
8 erendum containing the question set forth in subsection
9 (b).

1 (b) QUESTION.—The question referred to in sub-
2 section (a) is as follows: “Should the Congress propose
3 an amendment to the Constitution to limit Representatives
4 to 6 consecutive 2-year terms and to limit Senators to 2
5 consecutive 6-year terms?”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPILATION AND SUBMISSION OF REFERENDUM**

7 **RESULTS.**

8 The Secretary of State (or the equivalent official) of
9 each State shall report to the Federal Election Commis-
10 sion the results of the referendum provided for in section
11 1. The Commission shall compile the results and submit
12 them to the Congress.
