Mr. THOMAS of Wyoming (for himself, Mr. RICHARDSON, Mr. YOUNG of Alaska, and Mr. CALVERT) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To restrict the implementation of proposals of the Task Force on Bureau of Indian Affairs Reorganization.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTRICTION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF RE-**
4 **PORT OF TASK FORCE ON BUREAU OF IN-**
5 **DIAN AFFAIRS.**

6 (a) RESTRICTION.—Except as provided in subsection
7 (b), no reorganization proposal of the Task Force on
8 Bureau of Indian Affairs Reorganization established pur-
9 suant to Public Law 101–512 may be implemented until
10 the Task Force has recommended its implementation to

1 the Secretary of the Interior and such proposal has been
2 submitted to and approved by the Committee on Natural
3 Resources of the House of Representatives and the Com-
4 mittee on Indian Affairs of the Senate.

5 (b) EXCEPTION.—The Bureau of Indian Affairs may
6 submit to the committees referred to in subsection (a) a
7 reorganization proposal related only to management im-
8 provements, together with Task Force comments or rec-
9 ommendations, to the committees for their review and
10 disposition.
